

COVID-19 – Specific Apprentice Training

We are pleased to announce Ai Group has partnered with Deakin Co to come up with a micro-credential around Covid-19.

A trial is being run and all hosted Ai Group Apprentice & Trainee Centre apprentices and trainees will complete the training for **FREE**. This will be mandatory to ensure all our apprentices and trainees understand the full impact of Covid-19 and how to deal with situations and reduce, if not stop, the spread.

It is an online module and will only take around 20 minutes to complete.

The modules are:

- Module 1 - About COVID-19.
- Module 2 - How is COVID-19 spread.
- Module 3 - Understanding the Incubation Period and Symptoms.
- Module 4 - Behavioural Management Techniques in the Workplace, including Social Distancing.
- Module 5 - Handwashing.
- Module 6 - Sanitation, Coughing and Not Touching your Face.
- Module 7 - Managing Mental Health During COVID-19.

The Modules have been designed by high level doctors and professors including some who have been involved with the World Health Organisation.

At the conclusion of the training each participant will receive a lanyard stating they have completed the training. The training is designed to give an understand of how to reduce the spread of Covid-19 and keep yourself, your co-workers and your loved ones safe.

A full Australian launch will be held around May 8, 2020 likely to be on Sunrise and we will be looking for a couple of apprentices to volunteer to be in a couple of short videos and on TV, in their work uniform obviously!

This is a great opportunity for your apprentices and trainees, and for the younger generations, to take the lead in working together to overcome these tough times.
